One thing seems to be common about most of those great men. When God's Word got into their lives, they were able to overcome their fears and doubts. Moses became a great leader and eventually did much of his own speaking, even without Aaron. Jeremiah tried to hold it in but could not. Even Jonah, though he moped, preached to Nineveh.

It is still that way today. Get God's Word into your mind and life. His Word prepares us for the task ahead. Power and strength come with and are found in the Word of God. Try it out. You may be a "great" man in the making.
