

# I Was Mistaken about Thanksgiving

It was almost 20 years ago that I wrote a short piece about Thanksgiving Day and ti-



tled it "The Unmessupable Holiday." I'm not sure the adjective I used is even a real word. But it was coined (or usurped!) to communicate an idea.

In a word, the point of the little 400-word piece was that Thanksgiving had somehow avoided being spoiled by things that have "messed up" other major holidays in our culture. Christmas has become Santa, not Jesus; July 4 has morphed into beer and fireworks, not freedom and patriotism; and so forth. Boy, was I wrong! Or, if I was right then, it is no longer true!

Here is a quote from that essay: "Thanksgiving seems to have escaped the worst of holiday pilferage. It does not have the commercialism of Christmas or the drinking-party atmosphere of lesser holidays. It seems still to focus people on the positive things in their lives, to draw families together for meals and conversation, and even to generate prayers that acknowledge God as the generous giver of life's best things."

Thanksgiving Day 2013 surely failed to live up to that ideal. It was manhandled into a tasteless commercial affair. The CEO of WalMart was on early-morning television to defend it. And thousands of clerks, cashiers, and stockers had to report for work rather than gather with their families around a Thanksgiving table.

No less than the *Wall Street Journal* ran a weekend piece by Peggy Noonan that lamented the phenomenon. "[Thanksgiving] is the day the Pilgrims invented to thank God to live in such a place as this, the day Abe Lincoln formally put aside as a national time of gratitude for the sheer fact of our continuance," she wrote. "It's more important than anyone's bottom line. That's a hopelessly corny thing to say, isn't it? Too bad. It's true."

Nordstrom and T.J. Maxx, Costco and Dillard's - they were closed. Officials at Ace Hardware explained: "Some things are more important than money."

The reasoning behind corporate America's choice to slide Black Friday forward a day to create Dark Gray Thursday was that the shopping season between Thanksgiving and Christmas has fewer days this year. So maybe it was a calendar fluke, not the launch of a new routine. But I confess to being skeptical.

I have been so wrong about so many things that it doesn't shock me to have been wrong about this. Thanksgiving *is* mess-up-able. We've done it now. I just hope it doesn't become the new norm for the fourth Thursday in November.
