

Ephesians 5:16 -- Making the best use of time, because the days are evil (ESV).

These words from the Apostle Paul are just as true and needed today as they were when he wrote them hundreds of years ago. There is no denying that we live today in a world that has become engulfed in evil and wickedness that must imitate that time spoken of in Gen. 6:5; 2 Tim. 3:1-5; Rom. 1:26-32).. It is a time that reflects the sins of Sodom and Gomorrah (Gen. 19).

How can we be strong and remain faithful (1 Cor. 16:13) in a world gone so wrong? I suggest to you that we must have an attitude of commitment to love and serve God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength all the while believing that we can do all things through Christ who strengthens us (Mark 12:30; Philippians 4:13).

Dare to follow the example of Daniel (Dan. 1:8) by purposing in our hearts not to defile ourselves with the pollutions of this world. Purpose to serve and glorify God (Matthew 6:33; John 12:26; Heb. 12:28; Psalms 100:2; Rom. 15:6-7; 1 Cor. 6:20; 1 Peter 4:16). Dare to live above the crowd not letting a world gone so wrong dictate the kind of life we are going to live (1 Peter 4:1-6). Purpose to walk with God, respecting Him and keeping His commandments amid this sin laden generation (Gen. 5:22-24; Eccl. 12:13; 1 Peter 2:17; Rev. 14:7).

Be willing to pay the price in order to live right in a world gone so wrong. That price will include: A life of self denial (Matthew 16:24, 10:34-39; a life of work (Phil.2:12; 1 Cor. 15:58); giving the Lord a reasonable portion of our time in feeding on His word (2 Peter 3:18; 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Tim. 2:15). We must be willing to let God have full possession of our lives, holding back nothing. His will must fill our hearts, mold our lives and guide our lives every step of the way (Romans 12:1-2). In a world gone so wrong, we must be dressed in readiness with our lamps lit (Luke 12:35; Matthew 5:16; Matthew 24:42-44)). We must be active and diligent to remove any hindrance that threatens our eternal well being. Be patient, wait upon the Lord: Isaiah 40:31, Yet those who wait for the Lord will gain new strength; they will ,mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired; They will walk and not become weary.

Follow the example of Hezekiah from long ago, spread it before the Lord (2 Kings 19:14). He will hear our cry and he will answer (Ps. 34:15; 1 Pet. 3:12; Phil. 4:6-7; Heb. 4:16; 2 Thess. 3:16; Ps. 29:11; John 14:27). In a world gone so wrong, never forget for a moment that this world is not our home, we are just passing through on our way to a better country (Hebrews 11:13-16).
