

1 Chronicles 29:15

"For we are sojourners before you, and tenants, as all our fathers were; our days on the earth are like a shadow, and there is no hope".

There are a number of passages in God's word that emphasize the brevity of our sojourn on this earth (Job 7:6; Job 8:9; Job 14:1-2; 1 Sam. 20:3; 2 Sam. 14:14; James 4:14). Perhaps we should be measuring our time on this earth not by years but by days or even seconds.. I once saw a small mag-

net that had these words written on it: "When you are over the hill, time passes quickly". There was a time in my life when the days seemed to move so slowly but not anymore. Every tick of the clock, every sunrise is a reminder that I am getting older and so it is with all who read these words. It is a foregone conclusion that the older we get the faster it seems that days become weeks, weeks become months and all too soon the months have become a year. As we grow older our strength fades considerably. One day we are strong, full of energy and it seems as if nothing can stop us. Then all too quickly the aches and pains take over. We see our loved ones and our friends slip out into eternity one by one and suddenly it dawns on us how brief this sojourn really is (Psalms 90:10; Job 9:26; Isa. 38:12).

All things considered this earthly life has been an exciting adventure but the best is yet to come (John 14:1-3; 1 Cor. 2:9). I venture to say that each of us has had our share of joy and happiness on this journey, We have also experienced a lot of pain and heartache. Perhaps we should spend more time meditating on the words of Psalms 90:12: "So teach us to number our days, that we may present to you a heart of wisdom". I love the verse of the song that says, "Life here is grand with friends I love so dear, comfort I get from God's own word, Yet when I face the chilling hand of death, where could I go but to the Lord".

Our citizenship is in heaven (Phil. 3:20-21). Heaven, a grand, beautiful, spectacular home of the soul awaits our coming. In Revelation 21 John uses jasper, gold, precious stones and pearls to describe the majestic beauty of heaven. John also reveals the wondrous blessings that will be ours in heaven; no sorrow, pain, darkness, fear or tear will be found in that city whose architect and builder is God (Rev. 21:3-4; Heb. 11:10). Enjoy every moment, every day of your life but as you do so, never forget that you walk a fine line between living and dying (1 Sam. 20:3). Live each moment, each day in such a way that your calling and election will be sure (2 Pet. 1:4-11). Want it be grand to hear Him say, "Well Done".
