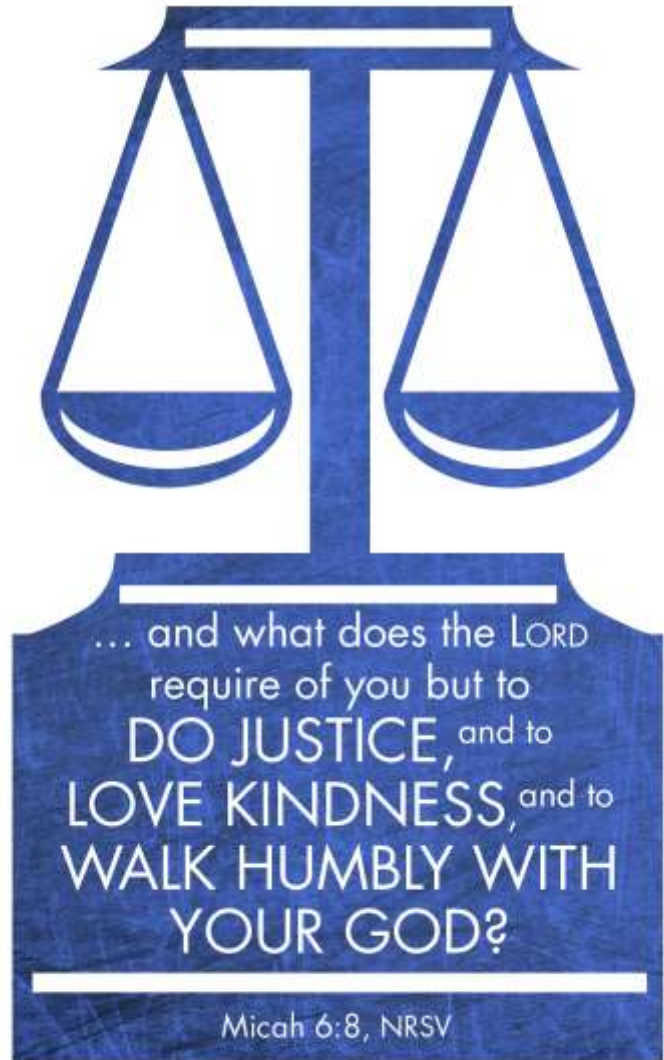

Bible Thought for the week

For God so loved the world that he gave his Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him--John 3:16-17

The eternal safety of those who believe in and obey the Lord is one of those exceedingly great promises found in God's word (Proverbs 1:33, 18:10; Romans 5:8-9; Hebrews 5:7-8). I often wish that I had the ability to reach down deep into my soul and find the words to speak or the ability to write the emotions of my heart so powerfully that all who hear and read

would be moved to do all within their power to make their journey to eternity a safe one. Those words fail me and I feel so limited. I would that all of us would, yea could, with a heart of sincerity cry out as did David in Psalms 16:1, "preserve me O God for in thee do I put my trust".

Be happy, enjoy your life to the fullest possible way. Have fun, treasure the moments you have with family and friends. But as you enjoy life today, never forget that the eternal safety of your soul depends on whether or not you obey and include God in your life every day.

God gave his Son that we might be saved, His Son gave his life that we might be saved. God and his Son have done their part, now the eternal safety of our soul is in our hands. What will it be, what will it be?
