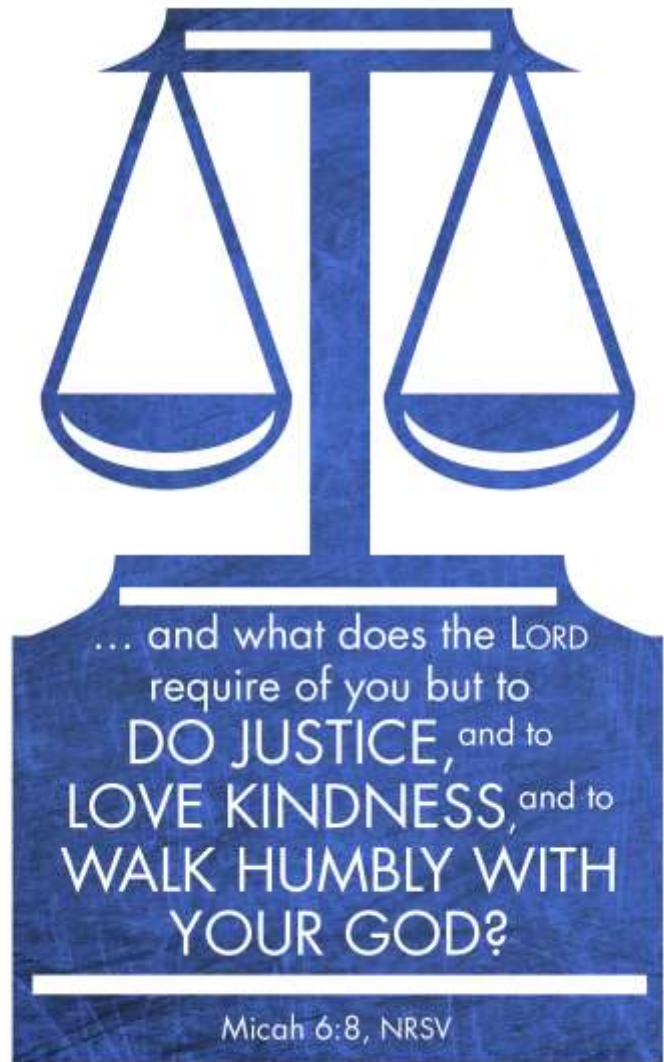

Bible Thought for the week

One of the most powerful statements of the entire Bible is found in 2 John 9: *"Whosoever trangresseth and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God....."*

At this moment I can think of nothing that would make this life more miserable than to be walking this pathway without hope and without God (Heb. 6:18-19, Eph. 2:12).

Today we live in a time of civil, political and spiritual unrest. that threatens to destroy the America we love. There is a deep seated anger that resides in the

hearts of multitudes of people causing harsh, critical, evil speaking to come forth out of the mouth of many. America is filled with all manner of unrighteousness, wickedness and deceit. The thoughts and imaginations of great masses of people seem to be filled with evil. Who would have thought that the time would come when not only would homosexuality and lesbianism be accepted but same sex marriage would accepted and endorsed by the people of this nation. Abortion, killing a baby while in the mother's womb, is an ever present evil in our society. And now, there are those who say it is permissible to kill that baby even after birth takes place. Every time I think we have reached the bottom of the barrel, some new and greater evil rears it's ugly head in this nation. America has some monumental problems.
