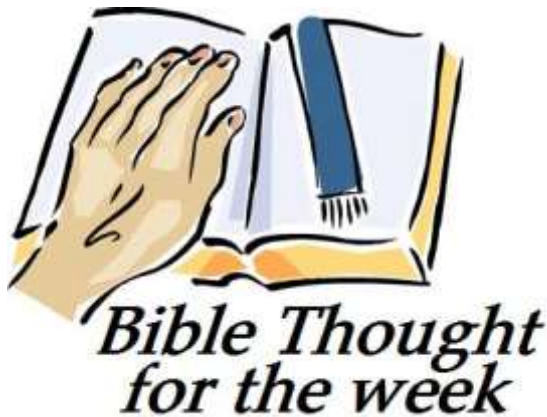

Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude--Colossians 2:6-7

The fourth Thursday in November each year is for many people a very special day. For many it is a day of feasting on delicious food; a day of enjoyment with family and friends; a day of relaxation with perhaps a little time spent watching football. It is also a day in which many people will pause for a moment and express thanks for family, friends, jobs and all the

many temporal blessings of their life. Some will even acknowledge God as the giver of these many blessings (James 1:17).

Of course there is nothing inherently wrong about this day that has been set aside as one to be thankful. However, lest we forget, having a heart filled with thanksgiving is not something confined to the fourth Thursday in November each year. Be ever thankful that through the blood of Christ we have redemption, even the forgiveness of our sins and have been delivered from the power of darkness (Col. 1:12-14). It is an awesome privilege to be a part of God's family. Be thankful for His mercy, comfort, peace and help to sustain each day (Phil. 4:6-7; Heb. 4:16). Be thankful for the word of God (Bible) that serves as our chart and compass as we journey onward to the land where joy shall never end (2 Timothy 3:15-6; John 14:1-3).

Let us live lives of thanksgiving to our God every waking moment of our lives. Even in those times when the road of life is rocky and hard, we have so much to be thankful for. As David says in the 23rd Psalm, "our cup overflows".

My friends, we need to start and end each day with a heart of thanksgiving to our God for all of His exceedingly precious blessings so abundantly given to us (Psalms 92:1-2).
