

...give thanks in all circumstances: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you--1 Thessalonians 5:18 ESV

When we arise each morning to begin our daily activities, we do not know what the day is going to bring into our lives. The circumstances that surround us may bring great prosperity or they may bring intense adversity. We simply do not know from one moment to the next what we will experience during the course of the day.

It is relatively easy to give thanks for the many temporal blessings we receive from God each day. The same holds true for the spiritual blessings that bring to us his abundant love, grace, mercy, joy, comfort and salvation (Phil. 4:4-7; Col. 1:12-14). The real test of being thankful comes when adverse circumstances surround us in this life. It is not a matter of whether or not we will experience those circumstances that will bring make us sad, cause the agony of pain, discouragement and even failure because those moments will come to all of us. It really is a matter of what we do when we find ourselves afflicted with the adverse conditions of life. These are the times that can, and often do, become life-changing situations.

Perhaps whether or not we are able to be thankful under all circumstances depends largely upon the level of commitment we are willing to make to the Lord. Is our commitment such that we seek first the kingdom of God (Matt. 6:33)? Is it one that allows us to love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind and strength (Mark 12:30)? Are we committed to laying up treasures in heaven (Matt. 6:19-21)? Is our commitment one in which every day we diligently seek those things that are above setting our affections on things above (Col. 3:1-2)?

If we can with true conviction in our hearts say as did Paul. "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me" (Gal. 2:20), then we will be able to give thanks in all circumstances of our lives.
